

## <u> 3rd Grade - Please label all supplies</u>

- Backpack
- Optional Face Masks Good to have for bus rides or indoor activities where we are in close quarters; your student will be asked to wear one if they begin having cold symptoms while at school
- Headphones for Chromebook use
- Athletic shoes (non-marking soles) for PE that can be secured/tied by student to be kept at the gym for the school year, once school is opened labeled with your child's name
- Shoes:

Good walking shoes should be worn every day, as we do a lot of hiking. If your student isn't tying his/her own shoes yet, please consider slip-ons or Velcro closing shoes.

- Emergency pocket size rain poncho to be kept in backpack
